

University of Waikato Parking Information for UniRec Members 2016

Why is the University introducing paid parking?

The cost of providing parking on campus to the University (land leases and maintenance) is approximately \$250,000 per year. Paid parking is being introduced to cover these costs and encourage the use of more sustainable transport.

When does paid parking come into effect?

Paid parking will apply from 2nd February 2016. Monitoring will be from 8.30am - 4.30pm, Monday - Friday.

If I have to pay, how much will it cost?

General Parking will cost a flat rate of \$2 per day and will apply Monday to Friday, 8.30am to 4.30pm. If you are parking in a general car-park outside of these times you do not have to pay, but you cannot park in a reserved Numbered Park at any time.

Pay machines accepting card payment are located adjacent to general parking areas and require registration plate number entry. You can pay by eftpos, or credit card (smart cards and pay wave cards work). There is also a cash machine located nearby UniRec for cash payments.

UniRec members attending more than three days per week may wish to take advantage of the student parking concession \$6 for one week (seven calendar days from time of purchase) available at pay machines. *Please note that a parking concession does not guarantee a parking spot if parks are full.*

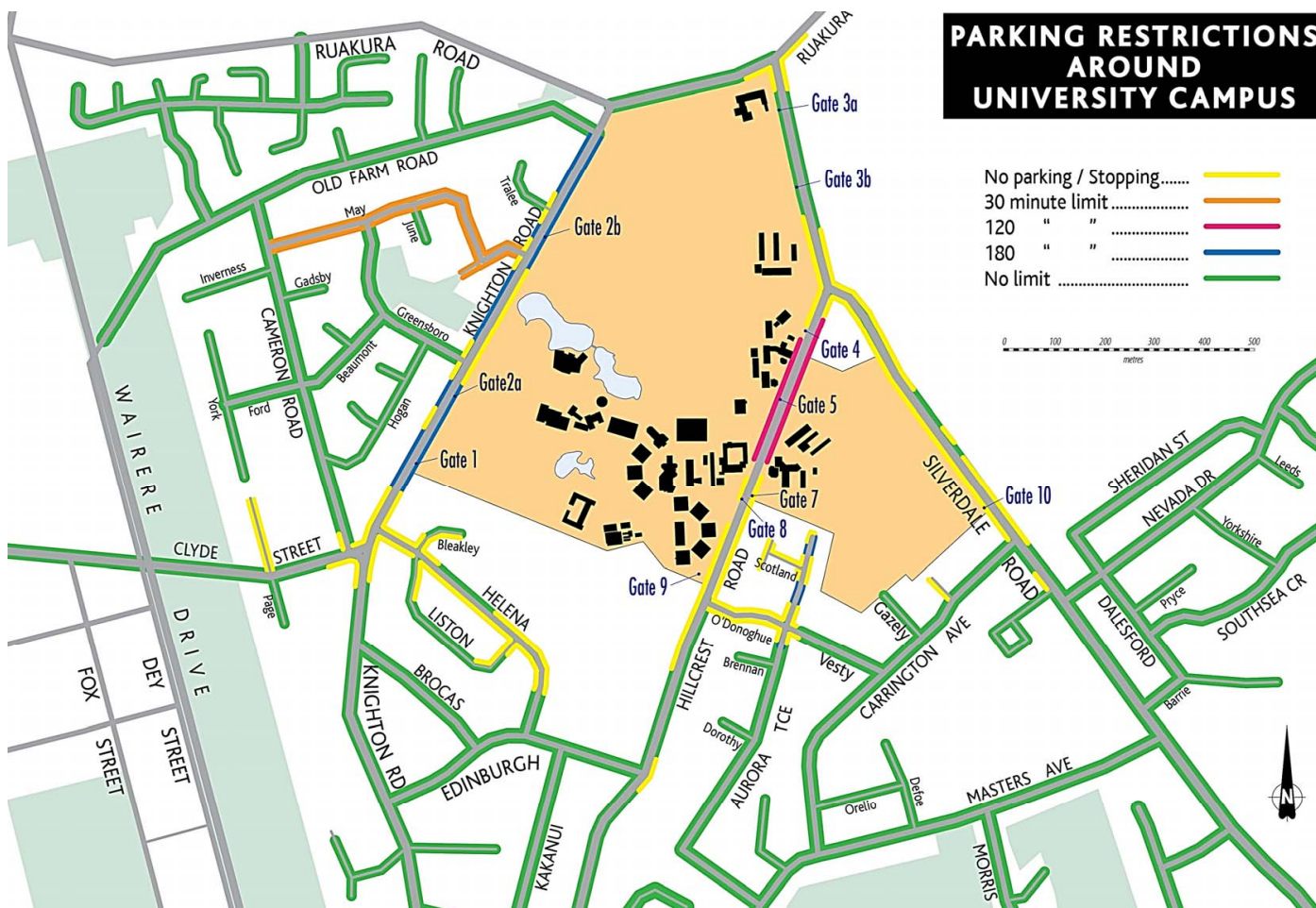
Does UniRec have designated parks for members to use during their workouts?

Yes, eight parks are located next to the grass area beside UniRec (see map on reverse). These have a two hour maximum limit and are reserved for members to use while working out (see terms and conditions on reverse).

Where else can I park for free?

180 minute parking is available on Knighton road by Gate 2B, only four minutes walk to UniRec. Free parking is also available on numerous streets surrounding the University campus (see map below).

UniRec Member Parking Spaces - Terms & Conditions Of Use

- A total of eight parks are available for UniRec members. These parks are located alongside the end of the UniRec building - accessible from Gate 1, Knighton Road through left-hand car-park (see map below)
- UniRec member parking is available for up to two hours per visit (during their visit to UniRec)
- The penalty for parking infringement is wheel clamping. The minimal cost of removal is \$50
- Members must display a UniRec member parking permit visibly on the dashboard of their vehicle. Passes should be collected from reception on arrival
